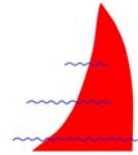

Booking Conditions

1. Your Contract

Your contract is with Professional Yacht Management (Pty) Ltd. The following terms and conditions will be incorporated into every contract between you and PYM. By making a deposit payment (either by supplying credit/debit card details or cheque) you will be accepting the terms and conditions both for yourself and all members of your party and you are therefore advised to read them carefully. This contract will be construed in accordance with South African Law and it is agreed between us that each will submit to the jurisdiction of the South African Courts.

2. How do I book?

Bookings must be made in writing on our booking forms and accompanied by a non refundable deposit of 50% of the full sail training fee. We will accept provisional bookings by telephone and will normally hold them for 5 working days (but less if made within 2 weeks of the commencement date of the course). The signed booking form must then be returned to our office. **FIRST DEPOSIT IN SECURES!!!**

3. Payment

A deposit of 50% is payable on booking and this confirms your berth. There will be **no refund on the deposit**. The balance of the fees to be paid 30 days prior to the commencement of all courses except for Yacht Master where full payment has to be made 6 weeks prior to the course commencement. **There will be no refund on full fees**. However should conditions beyond your control necessitate a cancellation – as long as this is 6 weeks prior to the start date, then you may defer the course to a later date as long as this is within 12 month of the deferred date.

NO FEE REFUNDS - PLEASE NOTE THIS CAREFULLY FOR ALL COURSE FEES PAID / DEPOSITS OR BALANCES OR FULL FUNDS

5. Yacht Insurance

Professional Yacht Management (Pty) Ltd will ensure and keep insured the vessel (s) used against all usual marine risks including third party risks to such an extent as Professional Yacht Management (Pty) Ltd, in its absolute discretion, shall deem appropriate. Such insurance policy does not cover injury to, loss of life (except that caused through negligence of the skipper), or damage to or loss of property of any person on board against which the student must ensure prior to the charter.

6. Course Termination.

You must accept responsibility for the proper conduct of yourself and any member of your party. We reserve the right, in our absolute discretion, to terminate without further notice the course arrangements of any client who refuses to comply with the instructions or orders of the skipper, company staff, agent or other responsible person or whose behaviour or competence in their opinion is likely to cause distress, damage, danger or annoyance to their crew, other customers, staff, any third party or to property.

7. Smoking/ Drugs

Smoking is a fire hazard and a dangerous activity on a small vessel. On long distance sailing – reluctantly and only in very special cases - smoking may be permitted, at the absolute discretion of the skipper, and at limited times and at a designated position in the vessel

DRUGS / BANNED SUBSTANCES : ANY STUDENT FOUND CONNECTED IN ANY WAY TO DRUG POSSESSION OR USAGE WILL BE INSTANTLY DISMISSED: NO REFUNDS OF ANY FEES PAID

8. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable if prevented from fulfilling any of its obligations by an incident of force majeure including an Act of God, weather conditions, strikes, lock out, act of Government or any other occurrence beyond control.

9. Carriage

Carriage there under is subject to the rules and limitation relating to liability established by the Athens Convention, as enacted in the Carriage of Passengers and their luggage, by sea – Domestic Carriage (Order 1987).

10. General.

The student shall not be entitled to assign the benefits of this arrangement to any third party without prior agreement of Offshore Sailing Academy and shall remain liable notwithstanding any assignment made by him / her.

11. Firearms

No firearms allowed on our premises or yachts at any time. (We are often inspected by the local water police and if found on board will be confiscated by them).

11. Indemnity forms

All students will be expected to sign an indemnity form on arrival. Should you be underage – please ensure you have a legal guardian present to sign on your behalf or request for these documents prior to your arrival.
